### IN THE EVENT OF A FIRE

**leave the building through the nearest Fire Exit and immediately make your way to the assembly point outside the Windmill Inn**

**From the Main Church:**

Exit into the side car park via the Fire Exit near the PA desk at the rear of main church;  
**OR** go along the corridor at the front left of main church, past the offices, through "Prayer Room" Fire Exit into the play area at the back of the building;  
**OR** use main church entrance

**Children and youth** will be escorted directly out of the building via their nearest exit by their teachers and led safely to the Assembly Point

**From Natters**, use the Fire Doors at the front of Natters, near to the main road.
