

IN THE EVENT OF A FIRE

leave the building through the nearest Fire Exit and immediately make your way to the assembly point outside the Windmill Inn

From the Main Church:

Exit into the side car park via the Fire Exit near the PA desk at the rear of main church; **OR** go along the corridor at the front left of main church, past the offices, through "Prayer Room" Fire Exit into the play area at the back of the building;

OR use main church entrance

Children and youth will be escorted directly out of the building via their nearest exit by their teachers and led safely to the Assembly Point

From Natters, use the Fire Doors at the front of Natters, near to the main road.
