IN THE EVENT OF A FIRE

leave the building through the nearest Fire Exit and immediately make your way to the assembly point outside the Windmill Inn

From the Main Church:

Exit into the side car park via the Fire Exit near the PA desk at the rear of main church;

OR go along the corridor at the front left of main church, past the offices, through the "Prayer Room" Fire Exit into the play area at the back of the building;

OR use main church entrance

Children and youth will be escorted directly out of the building via their nearest exit by their teachers and led safely to the Assembly Point

From Natters, use the Fire Doors at the front of Natters, near to the main road.

 - **CHRISTIANS AGAINST POVERTY** are running a Money Course in October at The Hub, Stanhope. This is a free course helping people to manage their money more effectively. The course provides useful tools to enable everyone to budget, save and prevent debt irrespective of their income. It will usually run over three Saturday afternoons (3-5pm.) At the moment, the course is planned for 5th, 12th and 19th October but it is possible the start maybe delayed by one week.  - **ASHFORD WINTER NIGHT SHELTER** – starting Monday, 16th December until Sunday, 15th March. Our night will be Friday again. This year, as last, training is compulsory; there will be a choice of dates for this, there will be voluntary First Aid training offered too. Please prayerfully consider whether you would like to be part of this. If you wish to be part of the Shelter, an Availability Form is included today so you can indicate your available dates (a Registration Form will also need to be completed). That doesn't mean, however, that you will be on every shift/every week! Even if you can only do one shift over the entire Shelter, we will be extremely grateful! Registration Forms that need to go back to Kareen in the Shelter Office are also now available either via email or from the Office.
 - **MEN'S CHRISTMAS COMEDY NIGHT** - Tickets will be available from next weekend for this year's Men's Christmas Comedy Night. It's a spectacular double bill this year with 2 different acts performing. The evening has a start time of 7pm for 7.15pm and there will be the usual 3 course meal provided and the price for tickets is £12 each during the 'early bloke' period which ends on 31st October. The price will then go up to £13.50.
