IN THE EVENT OF A FIRE

Children and youth will be escorted directly out of the building via their nearest exit by their teachers and led safely to the Assembly Point

From Natters, use the Fire Doors at the front of Natters, near to the main road.

Liz spoke three times for about fifteen minutes each. A number of folk gave their lives to Christ in the street – the majority were Muslim. Praise God! Sid and Liz are back in Bank Street on Sat 26th and at the Bank St service on Sunday 27th. Do go down to Bank St, on the street, on Saturday between 11am – 3pm and enjoy the church gathered al fresco sharing the gospel!
