CORE VALUE 3 – Integrity

Reading Psalm 15 1-5

INTEGRITY: Exhibiting integrity by being honest, demonstrating high biblical/moral standards and doing what is pleasing to God, whatever the personal cost.

Integrity is a relatively modern word and depending on the version of the bible you are using the word *integrity* can appear a lot or a little. Where it is used little words like pure, upright, honest, whole loyal are all used

Why not get a number of Bibles (that have a concordance and look up integrity in the Bible or go on line and use Biblegateway)

The Bible refers to Noah, Moses, Abraham, David, Jesus and even Stephen as men of integrity, why?

Integrity has three key themes;

When you segregate your life, you do not have integrity.

Authenticity; You keep it real, you're not pretending, you are not pretending to be someone who you are not. And if you have integrity you act the same whoever you are with and wherever you are

It also means **unmixed motivation.** It means you do the right thing, but you do it for the right reason it means your sincere, your straight forward. You can pray to talk to God or you can pray to impress others, one has integrity and one doesn't.

Society and possibly ourselves are so concerned with image and what we portray to others that we cover up the real us.

- In what ways do we cover up?
- Is it ever OK to lie to protect another person (the so called white lie?) and does this impact our authenticity and integrity?
- How do we segment our lives and if we do is there an area that is being neglected?

Review Psalm 15 1:5 NIZ and explore the challenges you face and how might you meet these?

You may want to use the checklist from Sunday to talk about the challenges and how we overcome the temptations;

- keeping your promises, they keep their word (verbal integrity)
 Proverbs 25:14
- 2. By paying your bills (financial integrity)
 Psalm 37:21 & Romans 13:6 (NIV) [6]
- 3. By refusing to gossip (relational integrity). Proverbs 11 [13]. Proverbs 10:18 (NIV) [18]
- 4. By faithfully tithing (spiritual integrity)
 Malachi 3:8 10
- 5. By doing your best at work (vocational integrity)Proverbs 18:9 Ephesians 6:5 7
- 6. By being real with others (authentic integrity)2 Corinthians 4:2

The messages around integrity are so challenging when have you had a real challenge to speak up on a subject (for your integrity) but it is not popular? How has God Helped or blessed you?

You may want to remind yourself of the blessings

The blessing of personal confidence. Proverbs 10:9, Proverbs 11:3

- Second blessing is you get a lasting legacy. Proverbs 20:7
- Blessing of rewards in eternity Matthew, 25:21
